Technical Requirements:

- Three (3) power outlets within close proximity to amps *minimum*.
- If using backline amps, equipment provided must either match that listed in the lineup chart above, *or* first be confirmed with the group *before the date of the event*.
- Microphones should preferably be Shure SM58 / Shure Beta 58 or equivalent
- Drum mic setup should adhere to following requirements at minimum:
Two (2) overhead condenser mics, One (1) Snare mic, One (1) Kick Mic
- Each member should have their own monitor.
- Enough time should be allocated for the group to conduct approximately 20 min soundcheck minimum, *not counting time taken for production crew to set up equipment. All gear shall be in place/powered on before soundcheck commences.*
- It is recommended that all microphones, amps, cables etc. provided by venue/production company have enough back ups in the case of unforeseen issues.

If any of the above requirements are unable to be met, please contact the group's management team to confirm before the date of the event, so that we have enough time to prepare for adjustments. Please see stage plot supplemental document for stage arrangement.
